

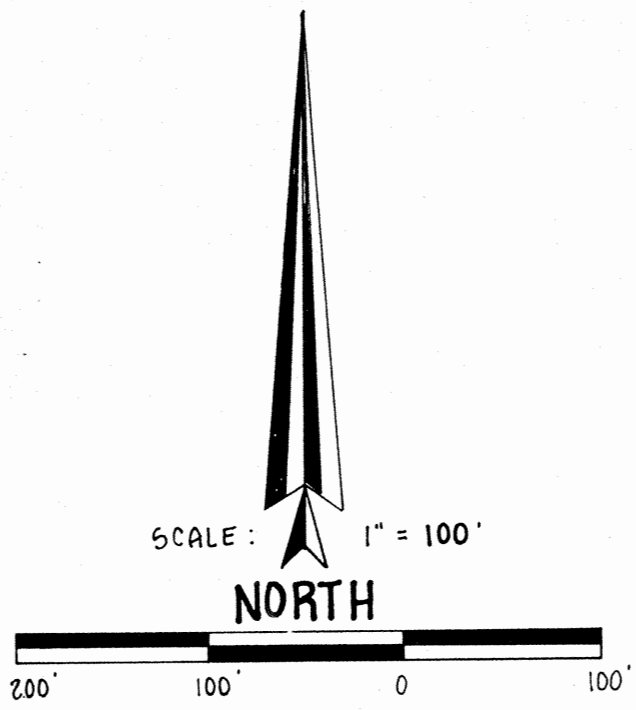

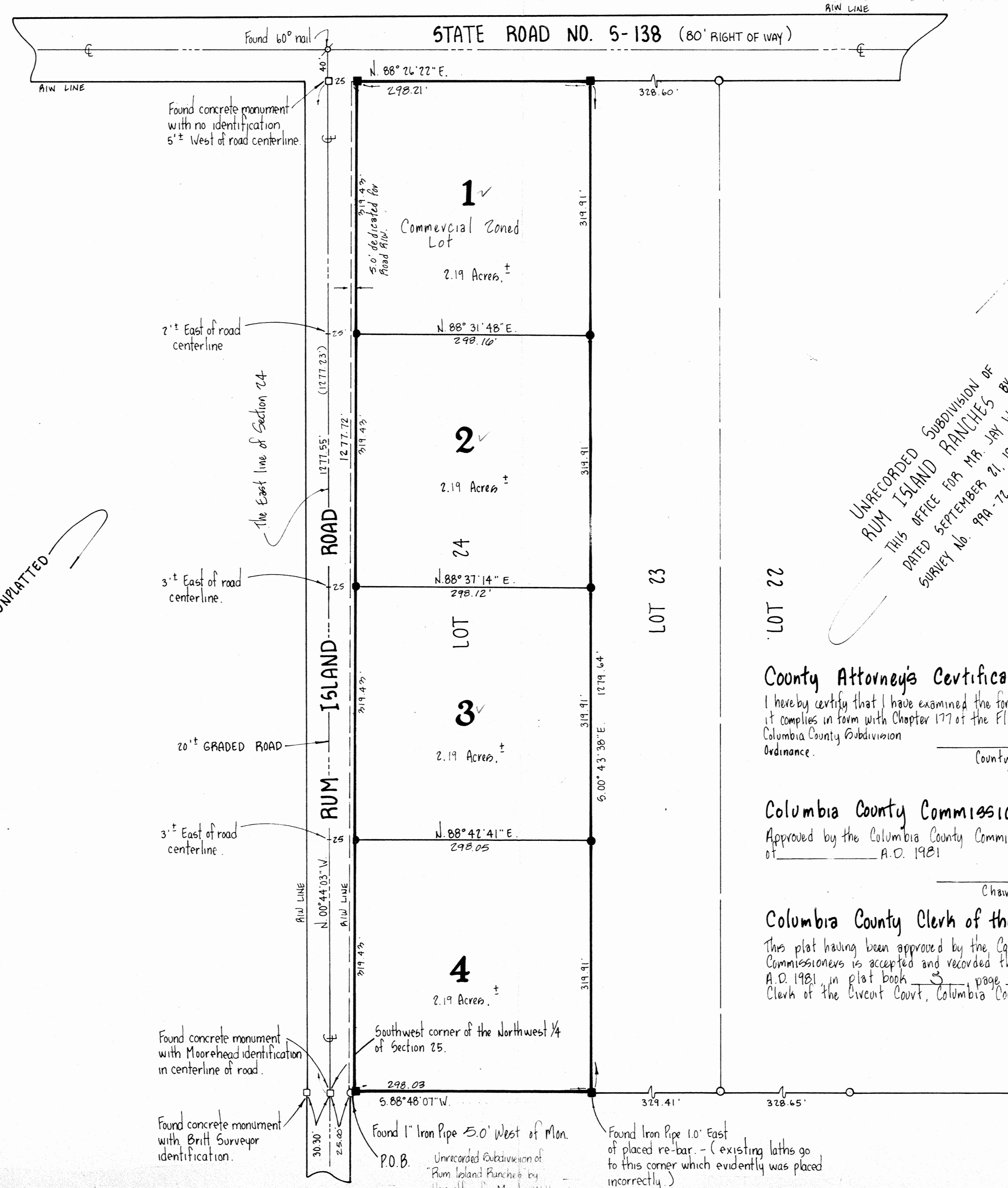

That part of Section 25, Township 7 South, Range 16 East, Columbia County, Florida being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a concrete monument marking the Southwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 25 for a point of reference; proceed from said point of reference North 88 deg. 07 sec. East, along the South line of the said Northwest 1/4, a distance of 20.00 feet to a 4 inch by 4 inch concrete monument at an intersection with the Easterly right of way line of a graded road 50 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 24 of Rum Island Ranches, an unrecorded subdivision of said Section 25, by M. H. Flowers and Associates, for Mr. Jay Williams, dated, September 21, 1972, Survey No. 99A-72 and the point of beginning, thence North 00 deg. 44 min. 03 sec. West, along the said Easterly right of way line and parallel to the Westerly line of said Lot 24, a distance of 1277.72 feet to a 4 inch by 4 inch concrete monument to an intersection with the Southerly right of way line of State Road No. 5-138, 50 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Lot 24; thence North 88 deg. 21 min. 22 sec. East, along the said Southerly right of way line and along the Northerly line of said Lot 24, a distance of 298.21 feet to a 4" x 4" concrete monument at the Northeast corner of said Lot 24; thence South 00 deg. 43 min. 30 sec. East, along the Easterly line of said Lot 24, a distance of 1179.64 feet to a 4" x 4" concrete monument with cap stamped "P.L. 6 2115" at the Southeast corner of said Lot 24, and an intersection with the said South line of the Northwest 1/4; thence South 88 deg. 48 min. 07 sec. West, along the South line of said Lot 24 and along the said South line of the Northwest 1/4, a distance of 298.03 feet to the said point of beginning.

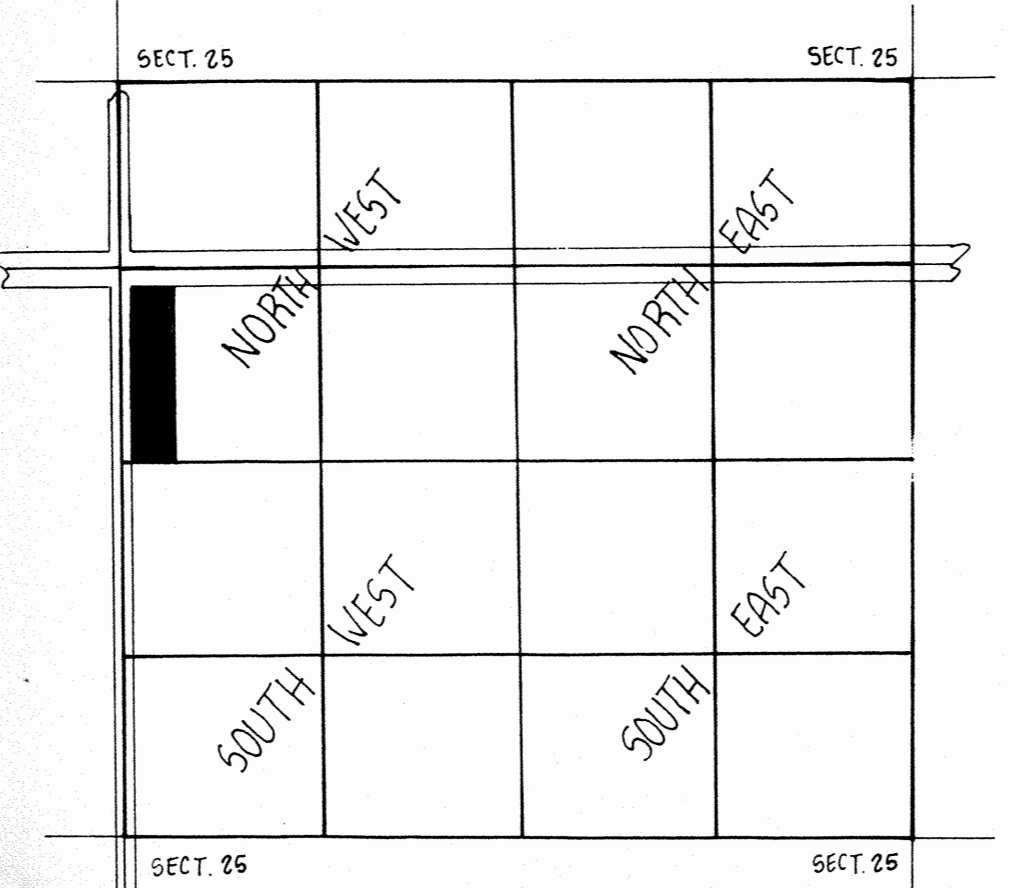
